

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I submit my completed Participation Agreement? Completed Participation Agreements can be mailed or emailed to Lisa Cook at the Perry Foundation.

Do I need to submit my facility's QM report and list of 20 residents when I submit my Participation Agreement? No. You will be asked to submit this information later. Please do not submit anything other than the Participation Agreement until you are given instructions to do so.

How much does it cost to participate in the project? It does not cost anything to participate in the Nevada MUSIC & MEMORYSM Initiative if you are a licensed, Medicare / Medicaid certified skilled nursing facility. If accepted into the project, the Perry Foundation will cover equipment and certification training costs (*not including laptop*). Each facility will receive certification for staff through training webinars and support provided by Music & MemorySM for one year and by Perry Foundation for the duration of the project, 20 iPod shuffles, 20 headphones, external speaker, splitters, AC adapters, and \$175 in iTunes gift cards. If you are not a facility that is a licensed, Medicare / Medicaid certified skilled nursing facility, you may still participate but at your own cost. The Perry Foundation will secure all equipment and invoice you directly, passing on the discounts we receive through our program.

Is there a deadline to apply? There is no deadline to apply at this time.

What can we do until we are certified and receive our equipment?

- ✚ Identify residents and begin discussions about their playlists.
